



## 2025 REP TEAM AGREEMENT

Rep Team provides the opportunity to train at an advanced level. It is recommended for students who want to be versatile performers, complement their training with exams and study many genres of the performing arts. Policies and procedures are created for this team environment which we believe provides the highest outcomes for each individual.

Students are expected to attend each class focused on learning and improving skills. They are required to act respectfully to their teachers, peers and the studio property. It is a privilege to be in Rep Team and there are responsibilities and obligations for accepting the privilege. Your child's enrolment in Rep Team signifies your acceptance of the agreement.

### COMMITMENT

- I agree to prioritise Rep Team over my other extra-curricular activities.
- I agree to maintain regular attendance to class.
- I will download the Caper App and respond to messages concerning availability promptly.
- I will assist in transporting props to and from performances.
- I will loan my child's costume to another student if I am unavailable for a performance.
- I agree to keep fees up to date on a weekly basis.
- I understand that if I enrol in more than one Rep Team, that each team requires 100 per cent commitment. *(If enrolling in more than one Team compromises your ability to commit to each team in full, please reconsider your commitment).*

### EISTEDDFOD DAY

- I agree to arrive to eisteddfods at the arrival time, with hair, costume, uniform and make-up ready to go.
- I will contact Caper if I am running late.

### CODE OF CONDUCT

- I agree that speaking negatively about other Caper students and children from other dance schools is not in the ethos of the studio.
- I agree to bring any concerns directly to Kate and Beth.
- I understand that Caper is unable to offer services to families who engage in aggressive or intimidating behaviour towards its staff.
- I agree to contact teachers through the Caper office. I understand it is not appropriate for students or parents to contact teachers directly through their personal communication channels such as mobile phones, email or social media.
- I understand that Caper is unable to provide Rep Team classes to students who attend other dance schools.

### COMPULSORY REHEARSALS

- I understand that attendance to all the Rep Team classes the week before a performance is compulsory. I realise that if my child is absent from the compulsory class that they may be ineligible to perform in that weekend's performance. I understand that by enrolling in Rep Team that I am agreeing to this rule and therefore will not be challenging the rule or seeking exceptions if/when it is applied to me.

### COMPULSORY CLASSES

A minimum of five classes per week is required to enrol in Rep Team (excluding Year 12 students, Ballet Rep and Tap Rep Team). The required classes differ depending on the age group and dance genre. Please refer to the separate Rep Team class guide of classes for more detail.
