At the end of the year we will be holding tap exams for our Junior students (Kindergarten and Year 1 age). We encourage all Junior students to participate (although participation is optional).

Exams are a wonderful way to learn about goal setting. We see an improvement in the skills of students who do exams as well as increased confidence and motivation.

The Junior Tap exam is part of the Glenn Wood Tap syllabus. We have been training our students in this syllabus since 2004 as it as a modern, enjoyable and musical style of tap that works on progressional learning and foundation skills.

This exam is for beginners and the syllabus has been covered in the Junior tap classes throughout the year. After the concert, the Junior classes will revise the exam syllabus so the students are ready to demonstrate what they have been learning for the examiner. All students will be able to perform the exam exercises at an examinable standard. No student should feel that they are not "ready" for the exam.

Who?

All Junior tap students (Kindergarten and Year 1 at school) are eligible to do a tap exam. Students wear their class uniform for the exam.

What?

This is an introductory exam with a Glenn Wood Tap Examiner which aims to be a fun and self esteem boosting experience.

When and Where? The exam will be held Sunday 1 December at our studio. Each exam will take approximately 20 minutes. Students are examined in sets of 2-4.

Why?

Exams are a great way to consolidate dance skills and motivate students. All students receive a report from the examiner and a medal from Caper.
